



John Stewart Elementary School Halloween Parade and Parties

On Friday, October 29, 2010 we will be holding our Halloween parade and parties. The parade will begin at 2:15 and the parties will follow at 2:30. Parents who signed up to assist with classroom parties may sign in at the main front doors beginning at 2:00 and can receive their visitor sticker at that time, but they will not be able to travel to classrooms until 2:30 or the conclusion of the parade, whichever is earlier. Please remember that per district policy, younger siblings are not allowed to accompany parents to classroom parties.

In the event of inclement weather, the parade will take place inside the school.

Morning kindergarten students will participate in their own parade inside the school and parties during their time at school in the morning.

Parties will consist of a healthy treat and one activity, and will last approximately 45-50 minutes.

Costumes **should not** have weapons or be bloody, gory, or particularly scary. Also, masks that completely cover the face can be worn outside during the parade but may otherwise not be worn inside the building.

Treat bags containing food/candy items cannot be distributed. Students wishing to distribute treat bags to classmates can only do so if the bags consist only of non-food items.

If your child's travel arrangements for the day are different from his or her normal routine, please send a transportation note to school with your child at the beginning of the day. We ask that you not leave voicemail messages, as they sometimes do not get picked up in time.
