One of the goals of Kaneland District 302 is to ensure the success of our students. To accomplish this, regular assessment of student learning has to occur throughout the school year. In order to make informed data-based decisions, we assess the students in a variety of ways at different times during the school year. These assessments help us assess student learning so that teachers can modify the delivery of the instruction to help meet the needs of our students. One of these assessments is the Illinois Standards and Achievement Test (ISAT). The ISAT measures individual student achievement relative to the Illinois Learning Standards. The results give parents, teachers, and schools one measure of student learning and school performance. Students are assessed in Reading and Math. Additionally, 4th grade students are assessed in Science.

Attached you will find your child's ISAT results. The document explains the meaning of terms used and provides national comparisons known as percentile rankings. If you have questions about the interpretation of an individual report, you are welcome to discuss the questions with your child's teacher or with me.
