Dear Kaneland Parents/Guardians:

At the August 25, 2008 Board of Education meeting, the Board approved a new pet policy for Kaneland campuses. The purpose of the policy is to ensure the safety of all Kaneland students, as well as staff and visitors to the schools. The policy reads as follows:

“It will be a violation of Board policy to possess an animal in a Kaneland building or on a Kaneland campus during school hours or activities, including drop-off or pick-up of students before and after school. School hours are defined as being from 15 minutes prior to the beginning of school in the morning and 15 minutes after the end of school. School activities often take place outside of these hours. Exceptions to this would be an animal that is acting as a service animal; present for an approved educational purpose; or, transiting a public bike path/walkway.

In all instances, pets must be handled according to local village ordinances. The School District reserves the right to have any bothersome animal removed from its grounds. Owners are responsible for having their pets leashed or caged and for removing any waste materials from school grounds.”
