In 1998, the Kaneland School District conceived and presented its first Fine Arts Festival, a celebration of the arts which strives *to encourage young people's involvement in artistic endeavors and to challenge them to develop their abilities*. Kaneland's Fine Arts Festival is one of just a handful of School District Arts Fests in the State of Illinois, and the only such event to include a public arts festival which combines student and professional artists, workshops and display/performances.

So much more than just a one-day event! For weeks and months ahead of the April festival day, the Kaneland faculty and Artists-in-Residence work with students at all grade levels, K-12, for hands-on learning in visual arts, poetry and literary arts, music, dance, theater etc. The culminating event is a free of charge, one-day festival, completely open to the public.

The Kaneland Fine Arts Festival is funded by grants from the Kaneland Community Unit School District No. 302, the Dunham Fund, Kaneland Parent Teacher Association, the Illinois Arts Council, and through donations from local corporations and individuals.
